"Placing a crease in the upper eyelid increases the definition of the eye. Some people feel that Asian eyelid surgery is performed to westernize the appearance of those of Asian descent, but that's not the case," says Dr. Halaas.

According to recent reports the number of Asian Americans undergoing plastic surgery has risen by 21 percent from 2011 to 2012, while Eyelid Surgery has risen 4 percent from 2011. Eyelid Surgery is the third most popular procedure in the U.S.; with 6.4 percent of all blepharoplasties being Asian Americans.

"Asian eyelid surgery can open up the eye for a more energetic appearance and create a resemblance to the 50% of Asians who have a natural crease in the upper eyelid," Dr. Halaas says.

NYC's Dr. Yael Halaas performs three types of **Asian Eyelid surgeries** depending on the unique appearance of each patient: full incision (for patients with thick eyelid skin or droopy eyelids), partial incision (double eyelid surgery for patients with excess fat), and double suture and twist (for patients with little excess skin or fat in the eyelids).

Yael Halaas, MD, FACS, is recognized as one of the best plastic surgeons in New York City. Fully bilingual in English and Spanish, Dr. Halaas has a special interest in the treatment of the aging face in both women and men.
